AGENDA ITEM NO. 1

DELAY IN SCORING OF WORKS :

Contractors are required to submit their works experience details while submitting application for registration in HEWP. Contractor submit following categories of works for scoring :-

(i) Executed through any Department/ Board/ Corporation/ University of Haryana

Such works are required to be scored by EE concerned of the Department / Board/ Corporation/ University.

(ii) Works executed outside Haryana or executed in Private sector

Such works are to be scored by Nodal EE of PWD/ IRWD/ PHED to whom the application of registration has been sent by HEWP for processing.

It has been observed that several of the works in the first category remain unscored by various Departments/ Boards/ Corporations/ Universities for a long time. Due to the non-scoring of works, applications of contractors for registration in HEWP remain pending for long time. The following is a list of Organizations where 5 or more number of works are pending for scoring for more than 30 days (as on 01/05/2023).

AGENDA ITEM NO. 3

CONSTITUTION OF TEAM AT THE LEVEL OF HEADQUARTER OF DEPARTMENTS /BOARDS/ CORPORATIONS / UNIVERSITIES ON-BOARDED ON HEWP TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE REGARDING HEWP :

The queries regarding the issues faced by the various Departments / Boards / Corporations / Universities are received by IT team of HEWP on telephone as well as through personal visit by the concerned officer/ official. The IT team of HEWP has to devote much time to answer said queries resulting in less time being available for making provisions for further development of the portal and resolving the tickets raised on HEWP. A team of 2 to 3 officers / officials well

conversant with HEWP needs to be constituted under the Chairmanship of concerned Nodal Officer to provide the necessary guidance regarding the queries raised by the officers / officials working in the Organization and if this team is unable to resolve these queries, the matter may be raised with IT team of HEWP. Although the videos of training on various modules of HEWP are available on Home Page of HEWP, an interactive session on various modules of HEWP can be organized for these team members after the same are designated at the level of respective Organization.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 4

RAISING OF TICKETS ON 'HELP AND SUPPORT' MODULE OF HEWP :

The user may lodge his grievance by raising tickets through 'Help and Support' module of HEWP / e-mail / phone. The following points need to be kept in mind while raising the tickets:

- (i) <u>Mentioning complete detail alongwith reference number</u>: Unique reference number has been assigned to the Tender / DNIT/ Estimates. But it has been observed that in some cases the same are not mentioned in description detail while raising the ticket. Further, complete detail of the grievance is also not mentioned in some cases. Lot of precious time of programmers is wasted to search such items resulting in delay in resolving the ticket. Thus proper reference number of items alongwith complete detail of the grievance need to be stated in the tickets.
- (ii) <u>Raising of tickets in correct sub category</u>: The activities of HEWP has been divided into the various modules. The user has to register the ticket in the sub category concerned with the module related to the grievance. However raising of tickets in the wrong sub category results in delay in resolving the ticket. The tickets need to be raised in the correct sub category.
- (iii) <u>Alternate phone number to be mentioned</u>: The provision has been made in the 'Help and Support' module of HEWP to mention the alternate phone number while raising the ticket. The phone number of the person well conversant with the grievance may be stated in the cell of alternate phone number as to when the officer concerned does not pick the call due to some reason, the programmer may make call to the alternate phone number to seek clarification regarding the ticket.
- (iv) <u>Uploading of screenshot and document concerned with the ticket</u>: The provision has been made in the 'Help and Support' module of HEWP to upload screenshot and document concerned with the ticket. The necessary screenshot/ document need to be uploaded while raising the ticket so that programmer may understand the problem and resolve it in time.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 5

DELAY IN PROCESSING OF REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS OF CONTRACTORS :

It has been observed that pendency of Registration Applications (received on HEWP) are increasing day by day as the concerned offices are not dealing these applications within prescribed time limit as defined under "Registration Rules for Contractors-2022".

The Nodal officers of IRWD, PWD (B&R) & PHED departments may issue necessary directions to all concerned offices to deal Registration Applications (delayed) on top priority basis as progress of the same will be reviewed in the meeting.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 6

ALLOTMENT OF WORKS AND POST ALLOTMENT ACTIVITIES IN OFFLINE MODE :

Instructions were issued vide Memo No. 107438-7460/HEWP dated 13/12/2022 (**Annexure 'B'**) that the allotment of tenders for all the Engineering works floated through HEWP may only be done through said Portal. The Finance Department has also been instructed vide worthy PSCM office note dated 23/12/2022 (**Annexure 'C'**) not to release payment for Engineering works where allotment of works or post allotment actions are carried out through the offline mode. However, it has been observed that various State Govt. Organizations are using HEWP for preparing estimates, DNIT and Tenders for Engineering works but allotment and post allotment activities are being carried out in offline mode. The instructions as stated above need to be complied with.

Further, the information regarding tenders costing Rs. 5 crore and above allotted on HEWP is to be supplied to DIPRL every fortnight. It has, however, been observed that several such tenders have been allotted by various Departments/ Boards/ Corporations in offline mode due to which complete information in this respect could not be supplied to DIPRL. The various Departments/ Boards/ Corporations which have allotted the tenders costing Rs.5 crore and above in offline

mode may bring in the meeting, a list of these tenders in the following format received from DIPRL.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 7

OFFICE / DESIGNATION MAPPING :

There is a provision in HEWP to map the Office/ Designation in the Organization with the Engineering offices / designations on HEWP. The Govt. Organizations recently on-boarded on HEWP may complete the activity of office Mapping/Designation Mapping on the Portal.

AGENDA ITEM NO.8

LIMIT OF EXEMPTION OF EMD AS PER THE CLASS ON CONTRACTOR :

As per Clause - 4 of Registration Rules for Contractors - 2022, the amount of work for which exemption in EMD can be given to Contractor registered on HEW Portal, is as under :-

S.No.	Class of Contractor	Amount of work (for which EMD is exempted)
1.	Class - I	More than Rs. 25 crore
2.	Class –II	Up to Rs. 25 crore
3.	Class - III	Up to Rs. 10 crore
4.	Class – IV	Up to Rs. 01 crore

The Class-wise list of contractors is available at the home page of HEWP. The name of registered contractors may be verified from this list before granting him EMD exemption so that any contractor registered in a lower Class may not get EMD exemption for works costing higher than the amount against the Class in which the contractor has been registered.

AGENDA ITEM NO.9

DELETION OF FINALLY SAVED ESTIMATES :

The power to finally save / approve the estimate is given by Nodal-Admins of particular Department & power to delete estimates is as under :-

(i) Estimates (Not Finally Saved) :-

These can be closed from the login of concerned EE.

(ii) Estimates (Finally saved / Approved)

These can only be closed by the concerned Nodal Officer off the Department.

However, a number of tickets are being received in IT-Cell of HEWP under portal related tickets for closing the estimates. It seems that neither Nodal Officers not the field offices are aware about this. The action regarding the closing of the estimates is required to be taken as per details explained above.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 10

UPDATION OF HRMS FOR REGULAR CADRE EMPLOYEES :

The data of regular employees is imported on HEWP from HRMS. If the data of any employee is not updated in HRMS, then he is not able to perform any activity in HEWP. After updation in HRMS, the data is reflected in HEWP on next day. Due to non-awareness, tickets are being received in HEWP to update them. But such updations are required to be done in the HRMS by the concerned Organization at its own level and such updated data will reflect automatically on next day in HEWP. In view of this, all the Organizations (using HRMS) need to keep their HRMS updated. The data of employees can be verified from 'Employee Directory' on home page of HEWP.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 11

IMPLEMENTATION OF HRMS IN ALL DEPARTMENTS/ BOARDS/ CORPORATIONS / UNIVERSITIES :

HEWP has been integrated with HRMS to import the data of regular employees. But some Boards/ Corporations are not using HRMS and data of their employees have been entered in HEWP by themselves. This data needs updations in case of transfer / promotions / long leave etc. Many officers of Govt. Departments are posted on deputation in these Organizations. The data of such officer is in HRMS but cannot be imported in these authorities as these Organizations are not using HRMS. Some other problems are also being faced due to this. Such Organizations not using HRMS need to implement HRMS.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 12

PERSUASION OF CONTRACTORS FOR DEPOSITING SECURITY :

Security (refundable One Time Deposit - OTD) is to be deposited by contractors for completing the process of registration. But is has been observed that they deposit this amount very late. The abstract list in this regard is at **Annexure 'D'**. The Departments in which these contractors are working may pursue them for depositing this amount.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 13

SHORTAGE OF IT PERSONNEL IN HEWP TEAM :

Presently, IT team of only two Departments (PWD-B&R and PHED) are working on HEWP. Approval has been received from Govt. for deployment of more IT resources action on which is under process. Some major Departments (ULB/ IRWD/ HSVP etc.) may deploy minimum one programmer from each Organization for the time being till the required IT resources is deployed in HEWP.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 14

IDENTIFICATION OF MASTER TRAINERS IN VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS/BOARDS/CORPORATIONS/ UNIVERSITIES :

The master trainers are required to be identified by each Organization who may be trained by HEWP team so as to impart training to field functionaries and other staff of the respective Organization.

CHALLENGES / ISSUES :

The Nodal Officers may discuss challenges / issues being faced by them in the implementation of HEWP.
